

**DISPUTE SETTLEMENT PROCEDURE**

1. If the Interested entity and / or the Participant considers that Amber Grid or the Team has not complied with the Law on Management, Use and Disposal of State and Municipal Property of the Republic of Lithuania, the Description of the procedure for the implementation of state property and non-property rights in state-owned enterprises, requirements of the EPSO-G Group Share Sale Policy, it may submit a claim to Amber Grid in writing (by Electronic means or by signature through a postal service provider or other suitable carrier) for actions or decisions taken by Amber Grid that, in the opinion of the Interested entity and / or the Participant, infringe its legitimate interests.
2. The claim may be submitted within 4 (four) Days from the day of dispatching information of the Team about its decision to the Interested entity and / or the Participant by Electronic means;
3. The claim will be considered by the Team only if it is received within the above mentioned term and if the claim is submitted to the Team before the date of conclusion of the Contract. The Team reserves the right not to examine a recurring claim for the same decision or action taken by Amber Grid. The Process may be suspended during the claim examination proceedings.
4. No later than within 6 (six) Days from the date of receipt of the claim, the Team must examine the claim and make a reasoned decision and by Electronic means notify the Interested entity and / or the Participant of the decision made the Team. At the same time, the Team will also inform of any changes to the procedural terms of the Process which were previously announced(if applicable). Amber Grid shall not enter into the Contract earlier than after 15 (fifteen) calendar days from the day of sending the notice on the decision made regarding the claim to the Participant who submitted the claim by Electronic means.
5. If the Team does not satisfy the claim of the Interested entity and / or the Participant, the Interested entity and / or the Participant has the right to apply to the court for 1) annulment or modification of the decisions of Amber Grid; 2) annulment of the Contract. The Interested entity and / or the Participant shall inform the Team about the intention to apply to the court within 7 (seven) Days from the date of notification of the decision on sending the claim to the Interested entity / Participant by Electronic means.
6. If the Team does not examine the received claim within the set term, the entity has the right to initiate legal proceedings in court. The Interested entity and / or the Participant must inform the Team about the intention to initiate legal proceedings in court within 7 (seven) Days from the day when the Team had to notify the Interested entity / Participant who submitted the claim by Electronic means about its decision.
7. Upon initiation of legal proceedings in court, the Interested entity and / or the Participant shall, within 3 (three) Days, provide to the Team with a copy of the respective request or action together with evidence of the receipt thereof in court.
8. All other issues related to the settlement of disputes shall be resolved in Courts of Republic of Lithuania in accordance with the legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania.
